Introducing the Reverend Frank Kinney

Frank is a retired Presbyterian Church in the USA (PCUSA) clergyperson. He prepared for ministry at Princeton Theological Seminary, receiving a Master of Religious Education in 1968 and a Master of Divinity in 1970. Ordained in 1970 out of Washington City Presbytery, he served the Lord in congregations in Wilmington, DE; Baltimore, MD; Cambridge, NY; Beaver, PA; and Casper, WY. He is currently a member of the Presbytery of Central Florida of the PCUSA.

He was married to the Reverend Bobbie Upson Kinney for 38 years and served with her in ministry till her death in 2006. He retired from active pastoral ministry in 2006 and met his new bride Sallie Thomas Kinney in 2007 in Israel. They were married in 2008 and live in Winter Park, FL and North Sandwich, NH.

Frank has served the church universal in various ways, focusing on renewal that comes through the person and work of the Holy Spirit, in evangelism, through training in conflict management in congregations, leading groups and leaders in Corporate Listening Prayer, ministry and teaching in Indonesia, spiritual retreats and historical spiritual pilgrimages to Europe and Israel/Palestine.
