Getting Started:

1. What characteristics foster commitment in a relationship?

Digging Deeper:

Read Hebrews 1:1-14; John 1:1-5, 14; Colossians 1:15-20

1. Review the description given in your sermon notes about Jesus. What surprised you or was new to you?
2. Examine each aspect of Christ's identity. How might each part of who he is help you with the challenges, troubles, or crises in your daily life? What confidence does this give you for your past, your present, and your future?
3. How might a full understanding of Jesus as found in Hebrews 1 help you to share the gospel more effectively?
4. What is the role of angels given in this passage? Is there any difference between this view and any former understanding you have held? How does this view differ from the view of angels found in pop culture? Though not spoken of in this passage, how does Christ's superiority caution us against exploring the paranormal? (new age, mysticism, ouija boards, horoscopes, astrology, mediums etc .) See Deuteronomy 18:9-14, Isaiah 8:19
5. If you feel comfortable, share with your group about some of the things that capture your heart above Jesus or compete with Him for your affection. How does this passage help you correct your thinking about them? Take some time to pray for each other, asking Christ to become your highest aim and greatest affection.
