Getting Started:

1. Back in school, what subject matter were you least attentive to? Why?

Digging Deeper:

Read Hebrews 2:1-9

1. What does it mean to “drift away”? What danger faces those who drift spiritually?
2. What are some things in your own life that make it difficult to hear God’s message? What distracts you from hearing His Word and tempts you to drift?
3. What role does doctrine have in helping us fight spiritual drift? How do the spiritual disciplines—prayer, daily Scripture reading, Bible memorization, fasting, journaling, etc.—help?

4. How is the salvation Christ offers different from the things the world promises will “save us” (e.g., materialism, success, personal happiness, etc.)?

5. Reread verses 5-8. What does it mean to rest in the already and hope in the not yet?

6. Reread verse 9. How did Jesus humble Himself to save us? How does the fact that He willingly chose to taste death compel us to draw near to Him?

Taking it Home:

1. Spiritual drift often takes place so gradually we don’t realize it’s happened until we find ourselves in a crisis. Ask the Lord to help you see if you have drifted from Him. Commit yourself to “pay more careful attention” to hearing and applying God’s Word each day.
