6. When you read Scripture, do you feel like you are in familiar or unfamiliar territory? What does Scripture have to do with our discernment and spiritual maturity? How can knowledge of the Bible help us discern good from evil?
7. Review the signs of genuine spiritual maturity. Which of these is most prominent in your life?
