Deuteronomy 6:5-9 instructs us to love God, love His Word, and teach our children to do the same.

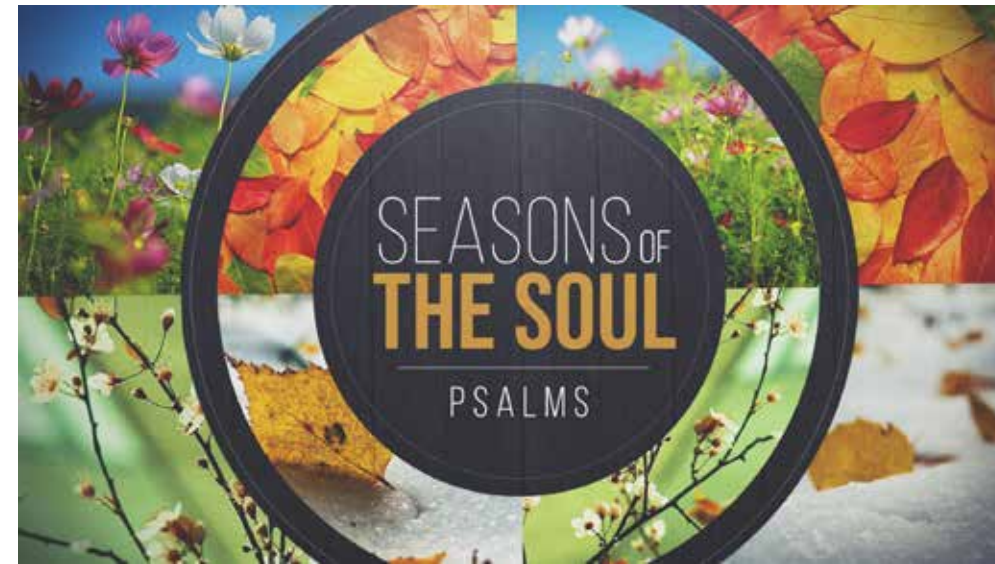
