Digging Deeper:

Read Luke 7 and Hebrews 3

1. List the people whom Jesus commended in these passages:

Who was He drawn to?

Who did He heal?

Who was His heart softened toward?

How are your priorities different? Why is that?

2. Our increasingly secular society has led to a plague of hopelessness, confusion, and lack of purpose. These are, at core, spiritual issues and knowing this can help us desire to personally engage in sharing the very good news of Jesus. What do you think? How might this impact our world?

How/why would the desire to share the Gospel change the life of the individual Christian?

3. **Read Matthew 28:18-20.** This is a passage that sent missionaries far from home to reach those living in spiritual darkness around the world. What are some challenges peculiar to this kind of life choice?

Most Christians do not leave their home country to share the Gospel, but we can support those who do. Share some ways you've helped in the past. Discuss if there are ways our GG might choose to encourage/help a global worker together. (A good resource for ideas is Dave Casto, Deacon of Missions dcasto8137@yahoo.com).
