If you would like to be baptized, please join us for the baptism preparation class on March 19 at 11:00AM in the library.

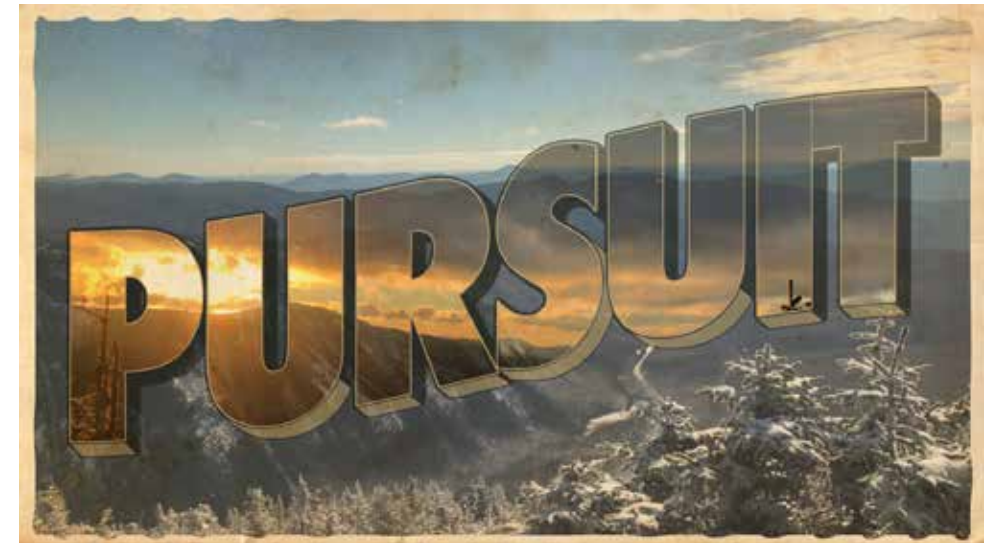
