The First Baptist Church of Meredith is currently hosting an ongoing GriefShare group. GriefShare is a special support group for people who are grieving the loss of someone close to them.

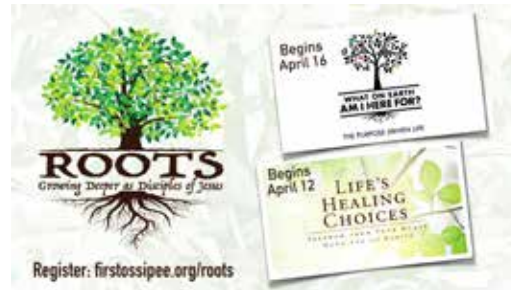

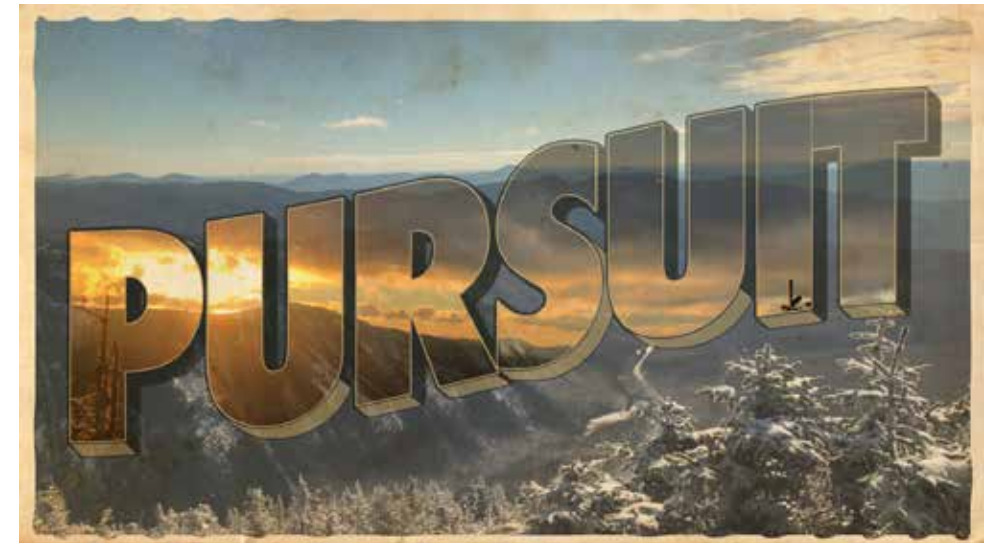
