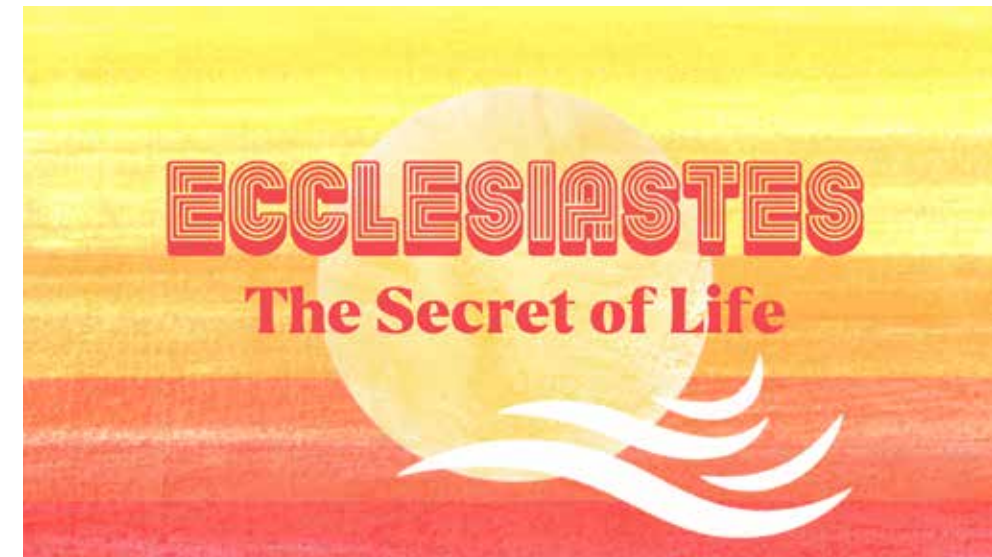
Can you and your family join us on Saturday, May 13, for an hour or two or the whole morning?
