For parents interested in participating, please register for the **Baby Dedication Class next Sunday** at 10:30AM in the library.

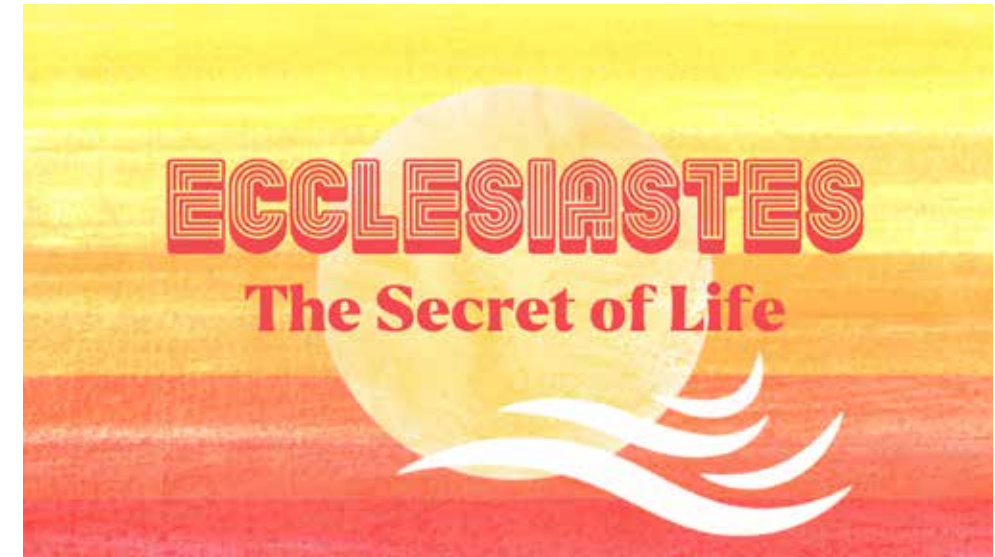


2023 Life Bridge Golf Tournament at Indian Mound Golf Club June 12
