October 31 -- Trunk-or-Treat

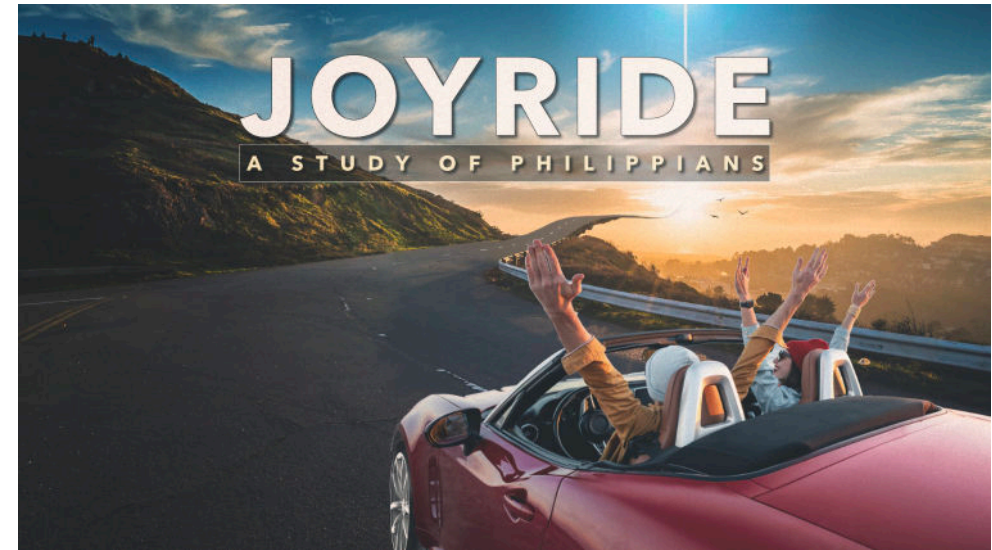
