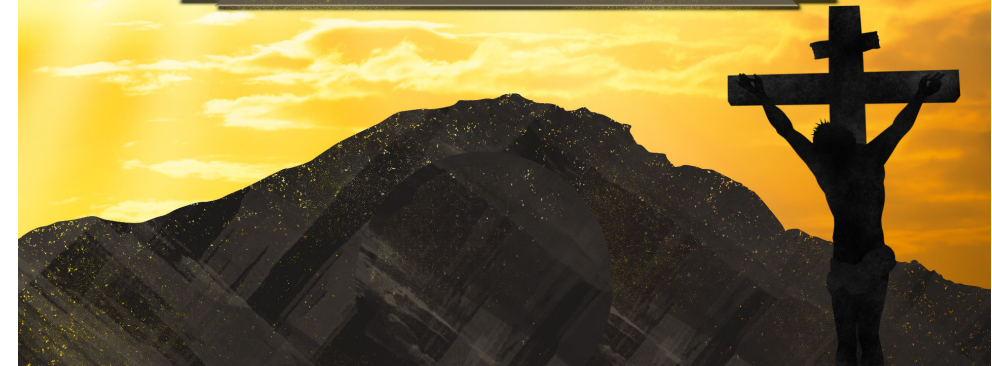

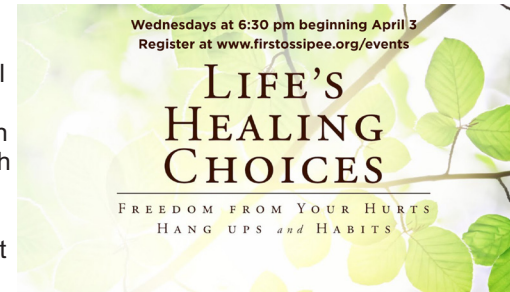
Pizza with the Pastors - April 7
