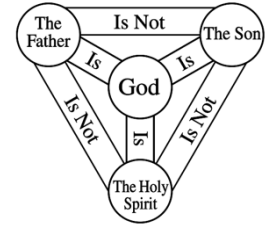

Getting started:

1. What thoughts, emotions, and questions do you have about the Holy Spirit? What is your perception of Him at this point in time?

Digging deeper:

1. **Read Genesis 1:26.** When speaking to Himself, God uses the word “us.” This is a reference to the Trinity. Who are the three members of the Trinity? What do they have in common? What are their different roles?
2. Our attention often focuses on God the Father and Christ the Son. But as the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, also deserves our praise, worship, and obedience. Why do you think we can tend to “forget” or “ignore” the Spirit?
3. **Read John 14:15-31.** According to Jesus, what is the Holy Spirit’s role in the life of a believer?

4. In John 14:17, Jesus said the Holy Spirit lives with us and is in us. What does it mean for the Holy Spirit to indwell us?
5. Review the attributes of God from the sermon outline. What comfort and encouragement do these attributes give you?
6. Review the four statements at the end of the outline. Which one is most meaningful or convicting to you?
