Getting Started:

1. Have you ever fallen for a lie or scam? What happened?

Digging Deeper:

Read Galatians 1:6-10

1. The Greek word in verse 6 for “deserting” means “to transfer one’s allegiance.” It was used for soldiers who revolted or changed sides. How is it appropriate for the Galatians as they are described here?
2. Why was Paul “astonished” by the Galatians? What might quickly “turning” away from devotion to Christ look like today?
3. How can soul-trouble and twisted truth tempt us to turn from Christ?

4. How do you account for Paul’s strong words against the teachers in verses 8-9?

5. The popular view today is that there are many ways to God. But the gospel says there is only one way to the Father, and that is through Jesus Christ. How are we to bring the message of Jesus to those who may be offended that He is the only way?
6. How do Paul’s words about pleasing Christ, not men, affect you? Do you struggle with the desire to please others rather than Christ? What might you do to fight this effectively?

2. Are you a people pleaser? How can you learn to live for an audience of one?
