Digging Deeper:

Read Galatians 6:6-10

1. What happens when we choose to sow to please the sinful nature? [Read Proverbs 22:8; Job 4:8; Galatians 5:19-21.]
2. Read Deuteronomy 28:1-6. What are the results of sowing to please the Lord?
3. Verse 7 assures us that “God cannot be mocked.” To “mock” means ‘to turn up the nose at’ somebody or ‘sneer at’ and ‘treat with contempt.’ How does this shed light on the times we attempt to disregard God’s ways and truth?

4. Have you grown tired of doing good? If so, how might you find fresh strength?

5. Reread verse 10. Why is doing good to the family of believers a priority?
