The Gathering - Sundays at 9:00 am!

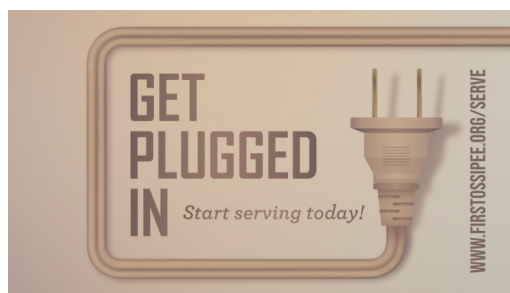
