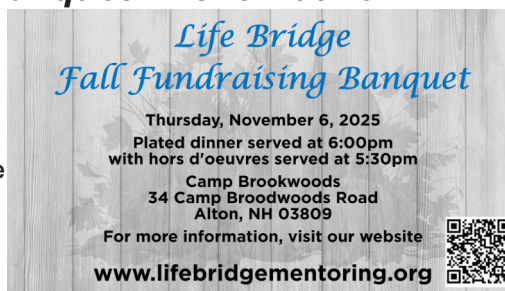
Surviving the Holidays - November 2
