Purpose Driven Life - Begins January 11, 2026

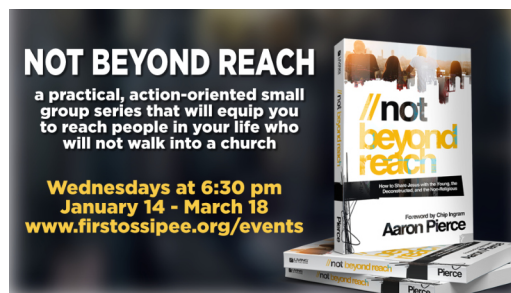
