Maundy Thursday Special Presentation - April 2

On Maundy Thursday we remember the night Jesus shared the Last Supper with His disciples—a meal deeply rooted in the Jewish Passover. During our special presentation of Messiah in the Passover, a guest speaker from Chosen People Ministries will guide us through a traditional Passover seder table, showing how this ancient Old Testament tradition points to God’s redemptive plan fulfilled in Christ. Exploring Passover helps us better grasp the faith of Jesus and His disciples, deepens our appreciation for Communion, and reminds us that the story of salvation is one continuous story—fulfilled in Jesus, our Passover Lamb.
