Elder Nominations - May 1-31



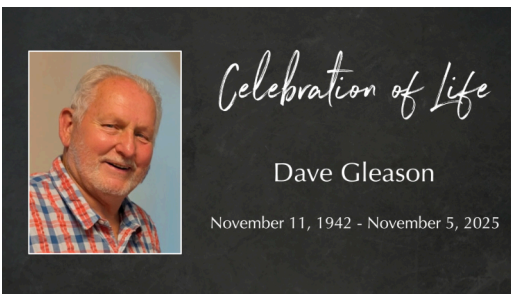
