Family Beach Day & Baptism - Sunday, August 23

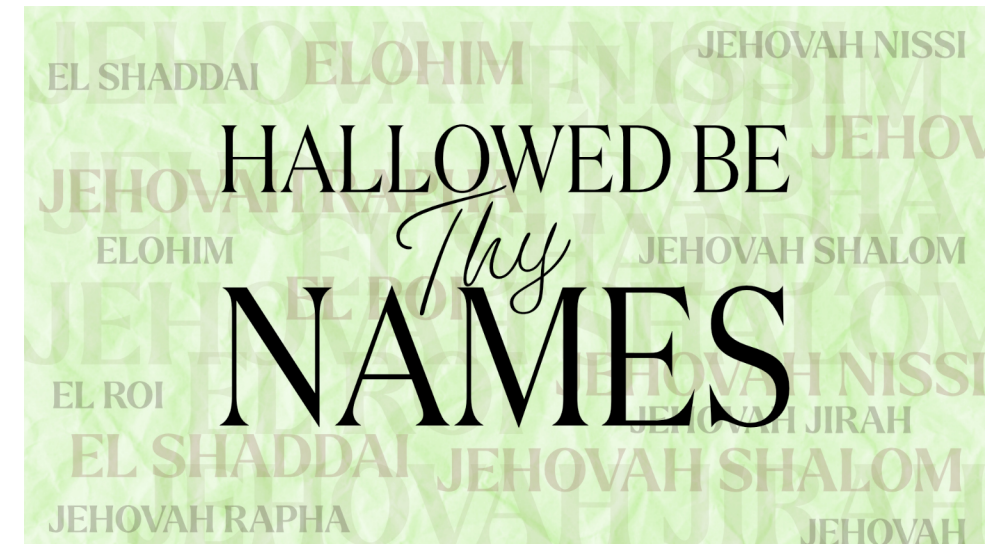

At Rainforest Falls Family VBS, we plunged into a lifelong adventure of discovering the nature of God. Families explored what it means to be rooted in relationship with God, their creator, a safe place in life's storms, through songs, skits, games, and Bible stories. We learned that God created the world, that God protected David when he hid from Saul in a cave, and that Jesus died on the cross and came back to life to show God's love. We had 36 families participate and collected \$334 to purchase mosquito nets for children around the world to protect them against disease. You can still donate to this VBS Missions Project online! VBS Missions Project

FCCO is partnering with World Vision to provide bed nets to protect kids from disease.

After decades of global progress against malaria, the disease has resurged in recent years. Children under 5 are most at risk, accounting for more than 75% of deaths from the disease in hard-hit areas. But the good news is that malaria is preventable with the right equipment and training!

Your gift will protect children by helping deliver super-durable bed nets made of specially designed insecticidal fibers that keep kids safe. You'll also help provide treatment and education for disease prevention and control.

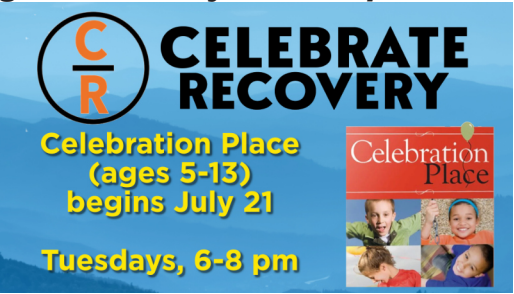
