Pizza with the Pastors - September 20

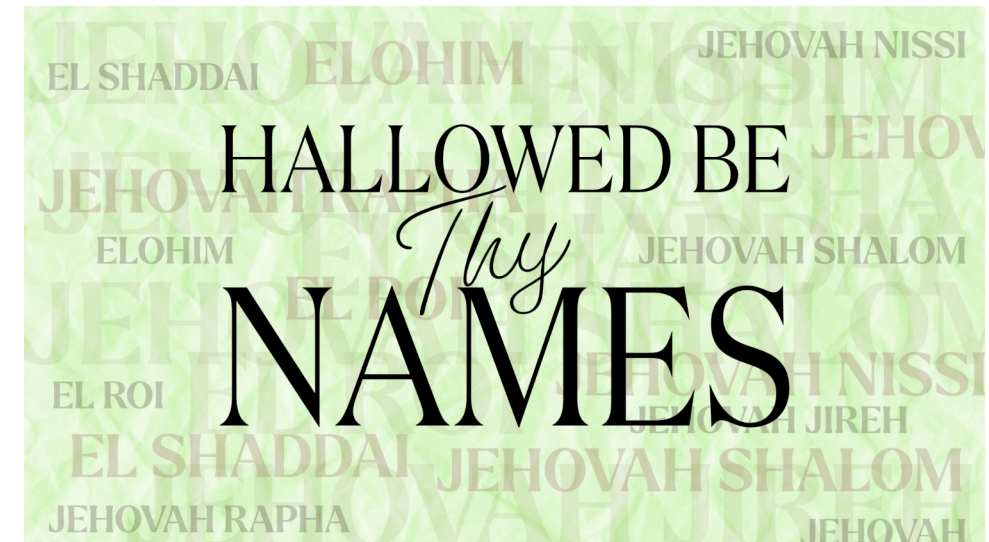

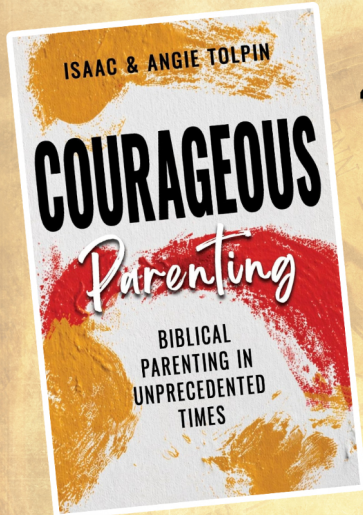

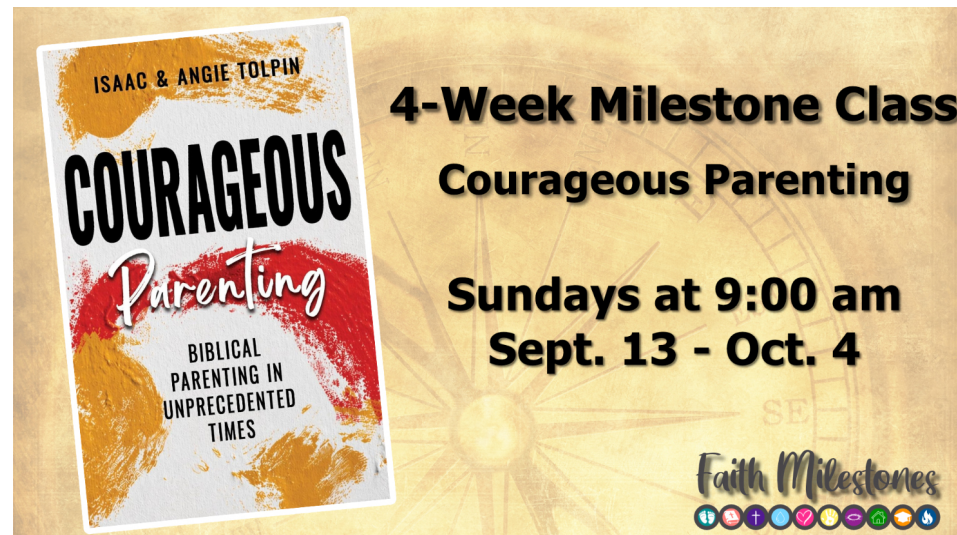
